

MONUMENT: \$5,000

Each station will have a plaque sharing the history of Shechem and how that parallels to the vision behind Shechem at Hope Street. Along the path we will explore Shechem from the promise given by God to Abram, to the tragedy of Dinah, and eventually into the heart of Samaria where Christ met the woman at the well. We see this very same story in the promise of Shechem at Hope Street - from God's promise to bless all people through Abram to the tragedy of brokenness that exists within Milwaukee, and finally to this space of refuge that will invite people to gather in an unexpected place, and to share in the hope of a greater Truth than stats and facts, but through unexpected kinship. Each plaque will share this story and vision of hope, of reconciliation, and of flourishing for all. Monument sponsors will be acknowledged when these plaques become stone monuments within the building of Shechem; additionally, monument sponsors will be acknowledged on Shechem's website. All monuments will be permanent fixtures within Shechem, and will continue to share the story of this space long after its construction.

BENCH: \$2,500

Along the garden's path will be seven places to pause, to read a part of the story of Shechem, and to reflect. At each station will be a bench for you to sit and take it all in, by yourself or with another. Each bench will feature a plaque honoring the sponsor, along with acknowledgement on Shechem's website. Benches will be placed at each station for visitors to sit, pause, reflect and pray while engaging with the vision of Shechem. These benches will become permanent fixtures of Shechem, in the atrium and the rooftop garden.

TREE: \$250

The first time Shechem is mentioned in the biblical narrative is when Abram goes to the "great tree of Moreh". This is where the promise to "bless all nations" is first received. Trees continue to act as powerful images that show growth, rebirth, shelter, and strength. Tree sponsors will be recognized on Shechem's website, and will also have the option to transplant their tree to a place of their choosing.

FLOWERS: \$50

Hope Street is the Greenhouse for People and this mission will be extended into and through Shechem. This means that Shechem will be a space committed to bringing light and beauty that is not just "good enough" but good in and of itself. The Refuge Garden will be an investment in the beauty of our neighborhood, and will bring beauty to the path for all to enjoy and learn more about Shechem. Flower sponsors will be recognized on Shechem's website.
