was an unexpected financial contribution, an encouraging word, or your coveted prayers - we were able to be sustained and push forward in saying YES to His plan.

God wastes NO thing, but uses everything to bring his name honor and glory. Thank you Father for the gift that is Shechem, thank you that you have been, and will be in every detail, at every step along the way. We trust you. We are counting on you. Thanks for letting us join in your kingdom work.

UPDATE: \$941,710 OF \$3,500,000 GOAL

We are still working towards our goal. With the help of a \$3 million loan from ForteBank in Hartford, we have started the building process! The first step of this was pouring Shechem's walls at Stonecast!

LEMONADE STAND

Last summer, a family that had just moved to the area came to our Bruised But Not Broken event. The family came and asked questions, the kids carefully painted reeds and the parents made a donation. We were so grateful to welcome in new supporters and we didn't expect more. Something that was learned about Shechem must have stuck with the family,

because a week or two after we met we got a donation from their daughter with the description "lemonade stand".

This little girl didn't have anything to give, but she wanted to be a part of something bigger than herself! This

isn't an uncommon occurrence here. We've received return envelopes with only a dollar or two in them and the address that is most prevalent in our Donor Software is 2522 W Capitol Dr., meaning our members are donating to Shechem too! There are a lot of people who really care about this project, enough to give away what little they might have.

DECLARATION OF INTENTION



A Declaration of Intention Card outlines how much you and your family intend to give over the next 3 years towards building Shechem. We are asking for these cards to be completed by the end of this year.

Why?

Thanks to generous donors, we paid off Hope Street's mortgage on our current building (2522 W Capitol Dr) and are currently debt-free. We have received a construction loan to build Shechem. We would like to remain debt-free by paying off the loan before the loan-period ends, Declaration of Intention Cards ensure we do that! In addition, securing Intention Cards and being able to show the support that is coming in, propels us forward in receiving grants from larger foundations and corporations!

Who?

Internally, we are invested. Our staff and board members have all filled out Declaration of Intention cards.

Externally, people believe in us. We have already received 630 donations and Declarations of Intention Cards towards Shechem from individuals, corporations, foundations and churches.
