Hope Street provides housing and healing to men, women, and children whose lives have been profoundly affected by the toxic environment they grew up in, their own choices, or drug and alcohol abuse. Empowered by the active Grace of Christ, the staff, volunteers and members cultivate a nurturing community in which we can live, learn and develop new habits that help people flourish.

What You Will Do

The Shechem Community Outreach Director will be responsible for connecting with churches, schools and organizations to gain supporters and share the resources we offer to the community. They will work to coordinate and plan several fundraising and community events on an annual basis. The Director is a reliable professional with knowledge of event planning, volunteer coordination, community relations, and obtaining financial support for the organization through sponsorships and other gift solicitation. Our supporters make it possible for us to consistently and passionately walk alongside the men, women and children we get the opportunity to serve. This is an in office position Monday- Friday at Shechem at Hope Street.
